AMG schools / colleges provide quality education, without any discrimination of caste, creed or religion, to orphans, semi-orphans, polio children, blind children, child labourers, stone-quarry children, children of the poorest of the poor, socially and economically down-trodden sections of society, tribal children, children of fishermen, children of lime- kiln labour, children of evacuated families and slum children and children of leprosy victims.

More than 12,000 children enjoy FREE education in AMG schools / colleges, in addition to food, clothing and accommodation. Children who could not even dream of having any education are now getting FREE education in English medium in AMG schools/ colleges.

**Residential Schools & Colleges :** The concern of AMG is to mould and nurture the future / lives of these neglected and marginalized children and aim at their wholistic development, because today's children are the nation builders of tomorrow.

Besides, FREE education (food; clothing and shelter) to about 12,000 students in residential schools & colleges, AMG provides education help / support to another 8,000 students, (studying in other colleges/courses) Text / Note Books, Clothes, college / school fees and monthly stipends.

## MEDICAL & HEALTH SERVICES :

AMG is executing projects to improve health of poor people, especially those who cannot afford costly treatment and also those who do not have any medical facilities. AMG runs the following hospitals.

## **CHILD CARE SERVICES**

**Homes of Hope-1976** : A group of 10 or 20 children are kept under the care of a Home parent and given education. There are about 1500 children in Homes of Hope in A.P.,

**Day Care Centres - 1978** : Children from slums and poor localities are provided mid-day meal and are also taught elementary education, in Chilakaluripet, Narasaraopet, Rajahmundry and Piduguralla.

**Milk Distribution Centres - 1978**: Infants below 2 years in slums, who are undernourished, are provided with milk in Chilakaluripet, Narasaraopet, Piduguralla, Vijayawada, Kakinada and Visakhapatnam.

**Street Children Homes - 1987** : Children, who ran away from their homes and became street and platform children are given shelter, food and clothing in the Home and are trained in trades, and sent to schools. AMG runs 4 Centres in Vijayawada, Rajahmundry, Samalkot and Chirala.

**Helping Hand-2001**- This project helps the children of Life & Long term prisoners. AMG is providing financial help for school / college fee and distributing books, bags, shoes, stationery and clothing every year to 250 children all these years. AMG is planning to extend this help to from 250 to more than 1,000 children. This is a great help / relief to the devastated families.

**Job and Business center Project - 2003** : JBC helps students, who have completed technical courses in AMG. They need practical training in real life situations in factories. AMG is sending course completed ITC Students to factories for training and experience for one year, paying monthly Stipend of Rs. 1500/- so that they can improve their skills and settle in life. AMG also helps JBC students to start own units with financial help upto Rs.25,000/-.

**Educational Support to children of Farmers Committed suicide - 2004** : AMG helps children of farmers who committed suicide, by paying school/college fees and also paying monthly Stipend for their food, besides providing school books, bags, shoes & clothing to 1,000 children in all districts of Andhra Pradesh.

**Dr. John David memorial GRACE project - 2006** : Through this project AMG is aiming to prolong the life of people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) and providing education support to their children. AMG is supporting 1,500 HIV/ AIDS patients by giving monthly rations of 10 Kgs Rice, 2 Kgs Dhal, 1 Kg Cooking oil, 1 bathing soap and 1 washing soap. AMG is also helping 1500 children of PLWHA by paying school / college fees and monthly Stipend for their food, besides providing school books, bags, shoes & clothing and encouraging PLWHA with income generation programme.

**Mrs. Ruth Deichmann Memorial Project - 2008** : AMG helping 500 blind people, by supporting them with monthly rations of 10 Kgs Rice, 2 Kgs Dhal, 1 Kg Cooking oil, 1 bathing soap and 1 washing soap. AMG is also helping 500 children of blind people by providing educational support to continue their studies.

## **EMERGENCY AND PERMANENT RELIEF**

**Drought Relief Programme - 2003** : Andhra Pradesh was affected with severe drought during 2003. AMG spontaneously responded and started relief work in 4 types.

**a. Cattle Feeding** : AMG provided Fodder daily to about 3,600 cattle in 4 villages.

**b. Mid Day Meal for Aged People** : About 5,000 people were fed daily in 10 villages.

**c. Monthly Ration Distribution** : AMG distributed ration comprising 10 Kgs of Rice and 2Kgs of Dhal per family to 5,000 families in Prakasam, Guntur, East Godavari and Visakhapatnam districts.

**d. Bore Wells** : AMG dug 115 Bore Wells in Prakasam, Guntur, East Godavari and Visakhapatnam districts to provide drinking water.

### **Drought Relief Programme – 2004**

**a. Bore Wells** : AMG has dug 125 Bore Wells in Prakasam, Guntur, East Godavari and Visakhapatnam districts to provide drinking water.

**Drinking water project (Bore Wells) - 2005 - 2008** : AMG has dug around 400 Bore Wells in Prakasam, Guntur, Krishna, East Godavari and Visakhapatnam districts to provide Drinking Water with the cost of Rs.2.0 Crores.

## **TSUNAMI :**

**Emergency Relief work (2005)** : AMG distributed emergency relief like Rice, Dhal, plates, Tumblers, Kitchen utensils, Pant & Shirt, Saree & Blouse and Blankets to 9,886 families in Nellore, Prakasam, Guntur, Krishna, East Godavari and Visakhapatnam Districts. An amount of Rs.85.00 Lakhs was spent for this programme.

**Rehabilitation work** : AMG distributed 10 Kgs of Fishing Nets; 5 Kgs of Rope; 5 Kgs Floaters; 2 Kgs of Sinkers to rehabilitate Fishermen in Nellore, Prakasam, Guntur and Krishna Districts. AMG also gave financial help to fishermen to repair boats / motors / nets. AMG spent Rs.3.00 crores for this programme.

**Housing** : AMG constructed 3,000 houses for Tsunami Victims in Nellore, Prakasam, Guntur and Krishna Districts by providing Rs.10,000/- per house as matching grant.

### **Emergency Relief Programme for the Flood Victims. October 2009**

1. AMG distributed one lakh Food packets to flood victims in Krishna & Guntur District.

2. AMG distributed Emergency Relief Material to **7,000** Flood victims in Krishna; Guntur and Kurnool Districts.

3. AMG donated Rs.6,50,226-00 to Chief Ministers Relief Fund, A.P. contributed by AMG Staff; Students of School & College and Beneficiaries.

**Rehabilitation of Leprosy Victims** : AMG has its roots in leprosy service. Besides running the leprosy clinics, AMG has rehabilitated in a big way, by giving them small jobs in - agriculture, piggery, weaving, rope making, sericulture etc., at the following centres.

Bethesda - Chengizkhanpet

Bethsaida - Narava, Vizianagaram

Valley of Love - Simhachalam, Vizag

Santhi Nagar - Titlagarh, Orissa.

**Monthly Ration Distribution** : AMG is distributing ration:to T.B Patients in Guntur District- 800, Leprosy victims in Prakasam District - 500, Guntur District - 450 and East Godavari District & Vijayanagaram - 1000.

## **OLD AGE HOMES**

AMG shows great concern for old people. The sun-set years for some old people are very difficult. AMG provides food, shelter, clothing and medical treatment totally free. AMG is presently running old age homes at the following places.
